Date: Friday May 1st at Georgian Court University and Saturday May 2nd at The Racquet Club of Philadelphia

Event Overview: Jay Gould, one of the legends of the game of court tennis, primarily played at two courts: Georgian Court, his family estate (now Georgian Court University) and The Racquet Club of Philadelphia. There will always be a linkage between the two as Jay Gould is arguably one of the greatest players of all time and he is still immortalized through the trophies displayed at the family mansion at Lakewood, the various photographs and works of art at both venues as well as the gold paint from all of his illustrious victories.

As we have successfully re-launched the court at GCU, we are hosting a day of play at GCU as well as private tours of the Casino, estate grounds (including the various gardens and lagoon) and family Mansion at GCU on Friday and play at the Racquet Club of Philadelphia on Saturday. "Friends of Georgian Court University Court Tennis" will also get a private tour of the squash tennis singles and doubles courts and fives court. We will also be hosting an optional cocktail party on Friday Night at The Racquet Club.

Competition: Casual doubles round robin paired by handicap. Players will be of varying abilities but will generally be experienced players.

Cost: \$100.00 minimum, per participant, which goes directly to GCU to preserve the court.
