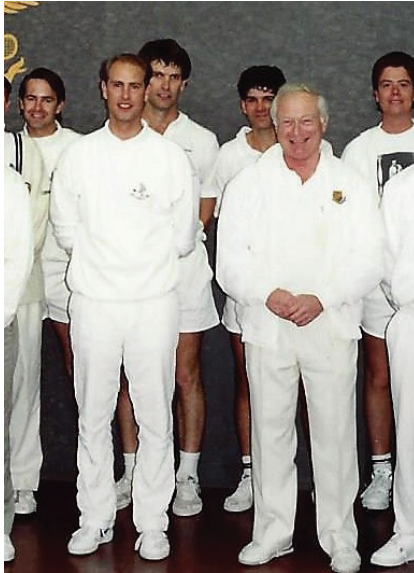
## SENTIMENTS FROM THE WORLD CHAMPIONS

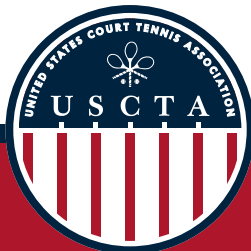

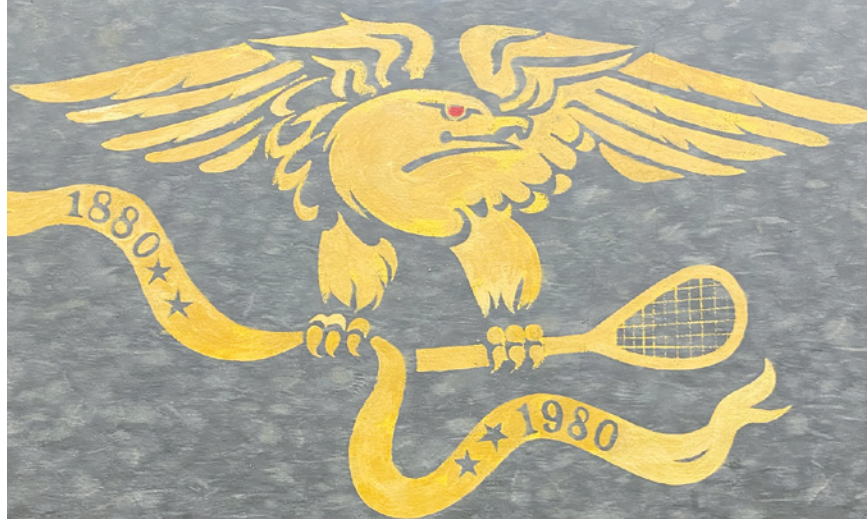
