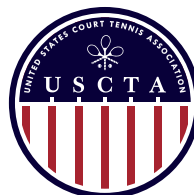

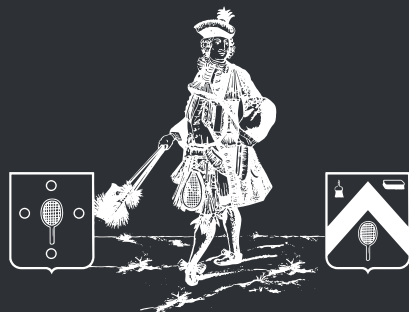
I invite you to enjoy the social events and camaraderie that this tournament is so well known for, alongside what I am sure will be a week of outstanding play on court.

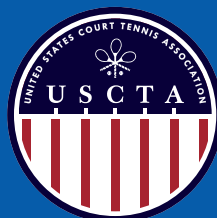

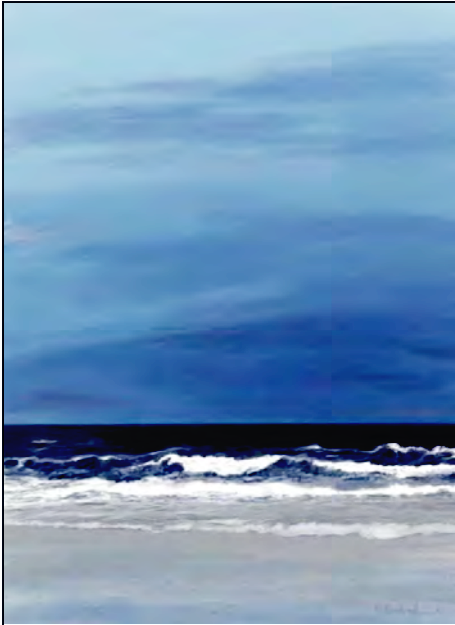
ALAN CHALMERS

IN HONOR OF MIKE GOODING

The National Tennis Club at the International Tennis Hall of Fame dedicates the 2023 United States Professional Singles playing for the Schochet Cup to the memory of Mike Gooding.

Mike's

journey in court tennis was an extraordinary one. He began playing in Scotland at the Sun Court in Troon at 14 years of age. He once said he knew he was getting good at court tennis when a Sun Court administrator complained about the noise from the grille being hit over and over during his solo sessions.



From there, Mike found his way to the top of the sport at World No. 2, winning the British in 1996 and back-to-back French Opens in 1995 and 1996. He was also an incredible doubles player, winning many Open titles, as

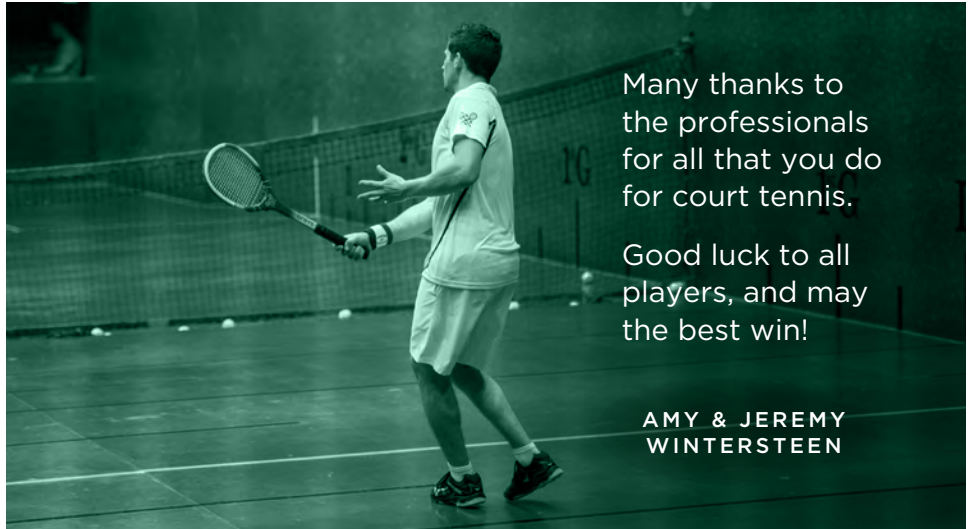
well as crossing over into racquets and winning a US Open doubles title with James Stout in 2013.

Over the years, he worked at Hampton Court Palace, National Tennis Club (twice), Racquet & Tennis Club, Georgian Court University in Lakewood, and Burroughs Court at Middlesex University.

Club players and professionals alike will remember Mike's enthusiasm for the game. In addition to being a world-class player in his heyday he was one of the better teachers and coaches later in his career.

Mike had a genuine curiosity, sense of humor, and devilish grin at times that made for laughs and lively conversations. In a lesson he could simplify the most daunting concepts and teach them with a simple and direct view. Mike's kindness, passion for the game, and drive to make everyone better around him was unique. We miss Mike greatly, but know his his spirit carries on in the game we all love.

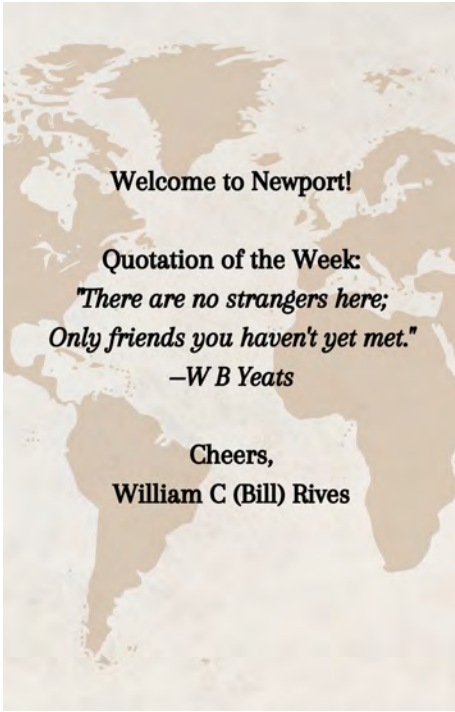

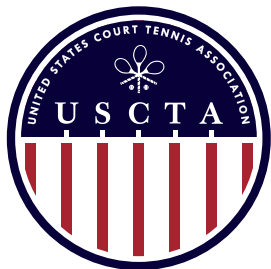
